DEADLINE: January 17, 2025

The Oxnard Educators Association will be awarding two **Robin Lefkovits New Educator Grants** in the amount of \$250, two **Darlene Killgore Middle School Science Grants** in the amount of \$200, and two **Suzanne Dempsey TK-8 Art Grants** in the amount of \$200 for the 2023- 2024 school year. Grants will be awarded to OEA members and selected by lottery. The purpose of these grants is to promote and support teachers who would like to purchase materials, attend Professional Development or fund special projects to enhance the educational experience of their students.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

1. The applicant must be an active member of the Oxnard Educators Association.
2. New Educator Grants will only be awarded to teachers in the first 5 years of the profession.
3. Middle School Science Grants will only be awarded to teachers in grades 6-8 who currently teach Science at one of the OSD Middle School or K-8 sites.
4. The Scholarship Committee will use the following criteria for selection:
 - Complete Application
 - Lottery

2. Include a short answer essay describing how you would intend to spend the grant funds as well as what this would mean to you.
